1. Obstructive Acute Coronary Syndrome Risk Factors

I have worked closely with data managers at the JKCI to develop a NCDR registry for acute coronary syndrome registry which will allow for the evaluation of the management and outcomes of ACS patients seeking care in that hospital critical information needed for the development of in hospital quality improvement interventions. Leveraging from registry, we described the prevalence, patterns, and predictors of angiographically-detected CAD among patients receiving care at the first and only public cardiac catheterization laboratory in Tanzania: We reported high rate of obstructive CAD in our study, prevalence that comparable to rates reported in registry data of patients undergoing coronary angiography in the US. In addition, the burden of CAD and its associated risk factors such as diabetes and hypertension were considerable in Tanzania and represent a major public health concern. In addition to this study, I have collaborated other investigators from India to evaluate outcome of STEM patients who underwent primary vs non-primary PCI in India. We demonstrated that outcomes among STEMI patients treated with primary PCI and non- primary PCI were comparable in a low-and middle-income setting. Results from both projects were recently presented at the American College of Cardiology Conference 2020.
